

# 2021 LADIES ASSOCIATION

COST: \$70.00 for Association membership, which includes IGA fees for World Handicap System (WHS) handicap, as well as Warm Springs Ladies Association dues. All members of the Warm Springs Ladies Association must have a current WHS handicap with Warm Springs Golf Course as their home course.

#### MEETINGS

Monthly meetings are held at the Warm Springs Club House on the first Tuesday of each month from March through October. Most meetings will be conducted half an hour before Day League play begins; some meetings may be held in the evenings to accommodate all association members.

#### TUESDAY DAY LEAGUE

FORMAT: 18-Holes (or 9 holes) of individual play in a social setting. Day league will play on Tuesday mornings from the beginning of March through the end of October; the shotgun start time will vary throughout the season (see schedule). Members should sign-up for Tuesday play at the clubhouse by noon on Sunday of the week before play. All players are asked to arrive 30 minutes prior to play to check-in and be ready to start at their assigned hole.

**GREEN & CART FEES:** Players are responsible for greens and cart fees each time they play in day league.

#### ENTRY FEES: POD ENTRY \$2, CHIP-IN ENTRY \$.50

Each week between April and October a "play of the day" (POD) competition is held, as well as a chip-in competition (both competitions are optional). Maximum handicap allowed for competition is 45; individuals with higher handicaps are encouraged to participate but their handicap will be adjusted to the maximum allowed. All POD scorecards must be turnedin to verify POD and Chip-in winners.

#### WEDNESDAY TWILIGHT LEAGUE

FORMAT: 9-holes of 2-lady best-ball play. Maximum handicap allowed for competition is 40; individuals with higher handicaps are encouraged to participate but their handicaps will be adjusted to the maximum allowed

Teams will be split into flights by their handicaps; where the lower handicap of your team determines the playing flight. Maximum handicap spread between playing partners is 10 strokes. If players with a 6 and 24 handicap want to play together, the 24 handicap player will have their handicap adjusted to 16 for the competition.

SCHEDULE: The Wednesday Twilight League will begin in mid-to late-April and play through late-July to early-August (approximately 14 weeks). The shotgun start is at 5:45 pm; please arrive early enough so you can check-in and be at your starting hole by 5:40 pm

NO SHOWS/LATE SHOWS: If neither team member shows up for play, the opposing team will play against the course using their handicap strokes on each hole to earn points. This team will automatically receive the low gross point. If a player shows up late for play, they may join their teammate and opponents; however, that player must forfeit the hole(s) that she missed.

SUB: All subs must have a current 2020 WHS (World Handicap System) handicap.

GREEN FEES: \$378 – this fee is for green fees for the 14 week league period, \$189 is required to be paid at the beginning of each 7 week session. Players who choose to ride in a cart should arrive early enough each week to pay the cart fee at the Warm Springs Pro-Shop.

ENTRY FEE: \$30 per player; winners in each flight will be awarded Pro-Shop credit at the end of each session. The Pro-Shop credit expires on December 31 of the year it was awarded.

# WARM SPRINGS LADIES ASSOCIATION

As required by the USGA and the IGA, the Warm Springs Ladies Association has established a handicap committee. This committee will monitor scores and handicaps of the members of the association. If we find irregularities in scores posted or not posted of our members, we will require those members to turn in an attested score card with each round posted. All scores should be posted by the individual player except Twilight League play and Ladies Association Tournaments; those scores will be sent to the IGA by the handicap committee.
